

## **Historical Background:**

Over its long history Wad Medani town has been regarded as the town of science and culture. The concept of the popular education started as an idea to break the colonial chain on education at a time the town folks were endeavoring hard to realize the national educational projects through the popular educational organizations whose fruit had begun to appear in the first half of the forties of the previous century, a thing made it possible natives to receive a non – govern total education.

Wad Medani Ahlia College was born in such atmosphere whose foundation was taken by the National Council for Higher Education and Scientific Research in the 9<sup>th</sup> of July, 1993, contribution to develop the rural community towards better horizons. This had been achieved by opening its doors the citizens to improve their performance supported by experience and knowledge so as to develop both the rural and urban people.

Thus, the birth of Ahlia College was a popular and national one whose gains and benefits return to the college building and the developing of its structures resembled in halls and laboratories, and working on promoting the potentials of the teaching staff at the levels of academic qualification and training. This means that the college is neither a private one nor seeking profits **b**.

The philosophy of the college is strongly based on qualifying and training both teaching and non – teaching cadres (researchers, lecturers and employees) beside women's developments in different fields of studies; and introducing specialized, social and complementary studies for individuals and college as a popular in capable of continuing and giving along with uniqueness and distinction, to reach such apparent objectives, the college adopted two basic principles:

1. Attracting highly qualified and trained cadres of from various times of prepared programmers of the academic syllabuses.
2. Planning study programmers according to the standards of the academic philosophy of which the college is committed to give.

## **College Objectives:**

Wad Medani Ahlia College was founded as an integrated modern educational institution so for as its programmers and administrations are concerned to respond to the present and of the future needs of the community additionally, the college contributes in building new generations capable of innovation and bringing about the required changes and modernizations in subjective and scientific ways in collaboration with all the concerned bodies all these have positively contributed in promoting the college financially and morally as seen in the following objectives:

1. Providing developed programmers for the students who have finished their secondary education successfully in addition to the mature students who have long work experience in order to offer there different scientific degrees.
2. Contributing in programmers for qualifying foreign languages teachers, especially the English languages teachers so as to upgrade their standards and strengthen their performance.

3. Encouraging scientific researches beside giving special attention for authorization, publication, translation and literary works.
4. Opening cooperation channels with Sudanese universities and other academic institutions.

### **Admission System:**

#### **Admission procedure:**

Students can apply through the high education committee (in Khartoum) by filling in the specified form; or directly through the college admission office in wad medani.

Students are required to provide the necessary documents.

#### **Admission conditions:**

Students applying for the B.A degree in any college admission office according the following conditions:

1. Obtaining the Sudan school certificate, or equivalent.
2. Passing the four main subjects in addition to the reeother of the admission qualifying subjects in any concert specialization.
3. Students who would like to apply for obtaining a diploma degree should have a success in:
  - The Sudan school certificate, or equivalent.
  - Five qualifying subjects required for admitting.

### **Academic System:**

The colleges follows semester and credit hours system as a basis of its academic plan. the academic year is divided in 15 tow semester. the duration of each semester is fifteen weeks. the credit hours range between is to 25 hours per week. each student get his/her grade at the end of semester along with his/her aggregational grade which represents the average of his/ her grades. this constitutes the final grade. the details of the academic certificates awarded is issued on the basis of grade obtained by the students in every with the number of hours . the grades are turned into points for every hours as follows:

The points for every course is counted by multiplying the grade points into the number of hours of that course. the (GPA) is counting by dividing the total points obtained by the student in the

semester by the number of the hours of that semester. however, the (CGPA) is counted by dividing the total points obtained by the students in the semesters by the numbers of hours of all semesters.

**Graduation Requirements:**

The minimum limit for awarding the bachelor degree is by obtaining an (CGPA) of 2.00, whereas minimum limit an for obtaining diploma is 1.500.

The minimum duration for obtaining bachelor degree is four semesters in case of regular studying. stipulating that two semesters of them to be immediately done be fore granulation. the minimum + duration (period of time) the student must attend at college to obtain a diploma is three semesters at least, two of them must be carried ont immediately before graduation.

they have substantial effects on the economic and developmental activities of any given community - either on collective or individual level. it is noticeable that all modern developmental plans aim at maintaining sustainability through incorporating the population component in economic and social planning for human communities statistics is considered the corner.

stone in studying any human activity, there for, all structures of studies related to economic and social activities have vital connections with statistics.

any one who closely observes statistics can easily see the considerable development which has come over this science.

this can be clearly seen in the basic concept and in the way statistics has been connected to social sciences, especially in the third world countries.

These countries are in urgent need for specific information.

Population science is one of the applied statistical fields. it has witnessed huge technological advancements through the introduction of computer technology and it is implicational programming to population statistical data.

Wad medani ahlia college works through this proposal to facilitate the realization of certain national, regional and inter national goals undertaken by the local community.

this comes within the frame. work of the message being adopted by the college since its foundation the very message has been working to develop family sciences programs , so that the collage can maximize its endeavours to meet urgent local community needs in the fields of statistics , population and women sciences and studies.

### **Academic Degree:**

The college awards a three – gear university diplomas in the following :

- (1) Applied statistics and population studies.
- (2) Women and community development sciences.

### **School of Agricultural Technologies:**

#### **Diploma in Trailers Agricultural Equipment:**

The college, in its incessant efforts to carry out the recommendations of a symposium on training development of the mechanized forming/agricultural technology organized by the college in 1997; and for its solid conviction that the mechanized farming/agriculture constitute the model method for solving the problems of agriculture in Sudan, obliged to execute integrated training programs in the mechanized farming/agriculture technologies. this will:

No double, meet all the argent needs of agricultural development in Sudan; improve technological levels; contribute much in enhancing technological capacity – building and qualify mechanized farming/agriculture workers.

There for the college provides an integrated academic program on mechanized farming/agriculture specialized in trailers and agricultural equipment this academic program aims at:

- (1) Qualifying and providing trained technological cadres at diploma level, who specialized in operating, maintaining and repairing agricultural trailers.

(2) Upgrading operational capacity of agricultural trailers and equipment. it is a three – year diploma . it concentrates on practical , training and field work aspects . this will be done in collaboration with wad. medani college of technology , university of Gezira and a support training center.

The college has secured the initial approval for trailers and agricultural equipment diploma program.

### **The Central Library:**

Wad medani ahlia college is undergoing a phenomenal infrastructural development.

This process has started with its moving into the current location at Al.daraja Quarter - Wad medani.

The recent years have witnessed the work completion at college's lecture – halls, labs computer workshops, office building, teaching staff offices, health center and prayer. hall. these beside launing and free – planting works and student rest house .

The grand library project has been the major concern of the college management.

The library university education, hence forth, the college has with the twin dimensions of the modern libraries – the traditional and the electronic educational center for the entire town.

The library houses a grand conference hall (with – 320 - seat capacity) a multi – purpose hall, book and art exhibition hall, a research scholars and undergrad students.

There are also audio visual section, a lab for people of special needs, internet hall for research scholars to get instant access to on – line international libraries and world encyclo pedia .

The library also offers CDS and films services.

The traditional library contains reference book encyclopedia, dictionaries, year book, atlas, periodicals and other useful scientific and artistic publication.

These services are readily available to teaching staff, research scholars, undergraduate students not only of the college but those of other colleges, universities, research center 5 at both state and national levels as well.

The library can receive one – thousand users at a time – community development council net in wad medani.

### **Community Service Program:**

#### **Basic Level English Teachers ' Training Program:**

The college, in collaboration with the Gezira state ministry of education has started a training program for the state. the program for the basic level English teacher of the British expert Mr. Lian Macowley in collaboration with the English teaching staff of the college.

The program undertakes to train about 2000 English teachers and teacher trainers.

The work is underway in 2002 with a comprehensive program which included stage offered special training for senior English teachers to qualify them to be teachers ' trainers.

The work will continue to the state. on a related issue the British council has been contacted through its director of Sudan branch. he visited the college and commended.

The efforts being exerted by the college to improve the work atmosphere. He also paid special tribute to the basic level English teachers' training program and promised financial support for the program.

### **Pre- School Education Diploma:**

The college has started a condensed training program targeting pre – school teachers and psychology graduates and other interested categories.

The study – duration is two full semesters with ten papers and field work. so far, two patches have been graduated.

### **English Language and Computer Sciences Course:**

The college has conducted a number of short – term courses which aimed at training public servants and college graduates and others. these included English language, computer literacy and special computer programs.

1. English courses for judges of Gezira state .
2. Medical statistics courses for physicians and dentists – university of Gezira.
3. Sign language course for applied psychology student and other interested categories.
4. Computer operation and internet course for bitar company's employees.
5. English language and computer courses for savings bank: employees – wad medani.
6. Short – term course for students and graduates.
7. An agreement has been reached with the Gazira scheme board to conduct training courses an accounting, management and computer for top officials of the board.
8. Establishing health center for the residents of al- daraja quarter, with a physician, nurses, a lab, a pharmacy and an intensive care unit.
9. Sponsoring artists and singers union in wad medani; and conducting a number of literary and conducting activities in the college.
10. The college has become the venue for the popular commite of Al-daraja quarter.

### **Academic system:**
